Exciting news! We've updated our solar Price Per Watt (PPW) limits, increasing the \$/watt allowance for Solar + Roof projects. These changes are now live. See below for the changes.

Important: Itemized costs on Home Improvement Contracts (HICs) are required for these updates

PPW Limit for Solar Only Projects

\$7/watt

- Energy efficiency and MPU add-ons are included in the \$/watt listed above

PPW Limit for Solar + Roof Projects

\$10/watt

- Itemized roofing costs are required on your Home Improvement Contracts

PPW Limit for Solar + Battery Projects

\$11/watt

- Itemized battery costs are required on your Home Improvement Contracts

PPW Limit for Solar + Roof + Battery Projects

\$12.50/watt

- Itemized roofing and battery costs are required on your Home Improvement Contracts

All non-solar add-on items can be included in all options above, subject to the 15% cap

In tandem with these changes, you will have to confirm whether the project includes a battery and/or roof if the system cost you input exceeds the Solar PPW cap. See below for what you'll see in Orange[®]:
